W. Waters. To have and to hold all and singular the said furniture, above bargained and sold, or mentioned and intended so to be, to the said John W. Whiteside, his executors, administrators and assigns forever, and I the said Geo. W. Waters, from myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, all and singular the said furniture, unto the said John W. Whiteside, his executors administrators and assigns, against me the said Geo. W. Waters, my executor and administrator, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant forever defend by these presents, of all and singular which said furniture I the said Geo. W. Waters, have put the said John W. Whiteside, on chair, at the sealing and delivery of these presents, in the name of the whole furniture; hereby bargained and sold, or mentioned and intended so to be, unto the said John W.
