 implements and horses, expressed and con-
 tained, in the Schedule hereunto annex-
 ed, that is to say, the two horses now in
 my possession, a set of harness for four
 horses, a crop of corn growing of twenty
 acres, two sud ploughs, one double shovel
 plough, one single shovel plough, one
 large diamond harrow and one culti-
 vator all and singular which said goods
 and Chattles are now remaining and being
 in my possession, I do have and I do hold,
 all and singular the said goods and
 Chattles or other premises above bargain-
 ed and sold, or mentioned and inten-
 ded to be to the said Rebecca Beasman
 her executors, administrators and assigns
 forever, and I the said Samuel Beasman,
 for myself my heirs, executors and ad-
 ministrators, all and singular the said
 goods and Chattles and other premises
 unto the said Rebecca Beasman her
 executors, administrators and assigns
 against me the Samuel Beasman my
 executors and administrators and against
 all and every other person or persons
