Thompson, and acknowledged themselves, each and severally to owe and stand justly indebted to the State of Maryland, in the sum of three hundred and fifteen dollars dollars to be made and levied of their bodies, goods and Chattels, land and tenements respectively, for the use of the said State;

Upon Condition nevertheless, that if the said Nicholas Thompson shall indemnify the said County from all charges that may arise for the maintenance of two male illegitimate children, by him begotten on the body of Catharine Hurst, of which she was delivered respectively on the nineteenth day of November Eighteen hundred and fifty two, and on the twenty seventh day of September eighteen hundred and fifty four last than this recognizance to be void and of no effect, otherwise to be and remain of full force and virtue in law.
