Jones all of Howard County and State above and acknowl-  
edge themselves each and severally to owe and stand justly  
indebted to the State of Maryland in the sum of one hundred  
and fifty dollars, to be made and levied of their bodies  
goods and Chattels, lands and tenements respectively for  
the use of the said State - Upon Condition nevertheless  
that if the said Alexander Durall shall indemnify  
the said County from all Charges that may arise for the  
maintenance of a female Legitimate Child by him  
begotten on the body of Serina Durall of which she  
was delivered on the seventeenth day January 1854 - the  
said Child being now two years old; And the Complainant  
desired the the said defendant to be released from the two  
years that has expired - and now claims only for the  
five years to come from this date - then this recognoance  
to be void and of none effect, otherwise to be in full force  
and virtue in law - taken and acknowledged before me
