One hundred dollars lawful money  
of the United States, in hand paid by William Hughes of said  
County and State at or before the sealing and delivery of these  
presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have  
granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant,  
bargain and sell, unto the said William Hughes his  
executrix, administrator and assignee One negro man  
Peter aged thirty five years to serve for ten years from this  
date (and from and after the expiration of said term often  
years I do manumit and liberate the said Peter from all  
servitude whatsoever). To Have and To Hold the said  
described Negro man Peter for the said term of ten years from this  
date to the said William Hughes his executrix, administrator  
and assignee forever; and the said Anna Igglehart for herself  
her heirs, executors and administrators, the said Negro man  
Peter unto the said William Hughes his executrix, administrator  
and assignee, against her the said Anna Igglehart her executrix  
and administrators, and against all and every other person  
or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever  
defend by these presents. In witness whereof we have  
hereunto set our hands and seals this eighteenth day of  
November Eighteen hundred and fifty six
