in consideration of the sum of
fourteen hundred and nineteen
dollars paid me by Ann Iglehart

of the County and State aforesaid, do hereby bargain and sell
to the said Ann Iglehart the following property to wit: - a
negro woman named Ann, about eighteen years of age; -
a negro boy, about three years of age; four horses; one
yoke of Oxen, six head of Cattle, eighteen hogs, thirteen
Sheep, two Colts, and all my farming utensils; all which
property and effects are now on the farm occupied by the
said Ann Iglehart, and of which she is now in the actual
possession - And the said Richard Iglehart covenants
that he will warrant generally the property hereby conveyed;
and he further covenants that he is possessed of, and is
the legal owner of the property hereby conveyed, and that he
has a right to convey as aforesaid - This paper is executed
to correct an omission in the acknowledgment of a bill of
Sale made between the parties hereto, on the 14th day of
March 1856, wherein the affidavit of the grantor required
by the act 1846 Ch. 241, was accidentally omitted -
