

and agree to teach and instruct the said apprentice or cause her to be instructed in the art of Housekeeping by the best way or means he can, and shall well and faithfully find & provide for the said apprentice good and sufficient meat drink, clothing, lodging, and other necessaries fit and convenient for such an apprentice during the term aforesaid. And during the term of service pay unto the said Maria Bell the sum of twenty dollars, and at the expiration thereof shall give unto the said Susan Bell the said apprentice two suits of wearing apparel, one suitable for Sunday and the other for working days.

 Charles Hanson
 & others.

I Amos Iglehart of Howard County and State of Maryland do hereby manumit and set free my negroes slaves to wit, - Charles Hanson to serve two years from the fourteenth day of

February Eighteen hundred and fifty seven. Amos Hall age fifteen years on 26th of December Eighteen hundred and fifty six to serve twenty five years from the 26th of December Eighteen hundred and fifty seven, untill he arrives at the age of forty years, and Mary Furdon daughter of Angelina Furdon, age six years on the 10th of December Eighteen hundred and fifty six, to serve twenty nine years untill she arrives at the age of thirty four years, the freedom of the several negroes herebefore mentioned or named to take place at the period of time herebefore mentioned.
