Willy Turner  
Indenture of Apprenticeship  
to  
Conrad Hagleman

This Indenture, made this  
fourteenth day of February in the  
year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and fifty seven,  
between Willy Turner of Howard  
County in the State of Maryland of the one part, and Conrad  
Hagleman of County & State aforesaid of the other part:

Witnesseth, that the said Willy Turner hath placed and bound out by these presents doth place and bind out his son, Isaiah Turner, who on the seventh day of January next will be of the age of twenty years, as an apprentice to the said Conrad Hagleman, to learn the art, trade and mystery of a farmer, after the manner of an apprentice, the said Isaiah Turner to dwell with and serve the said Conrad Hagleman, from the date of these presents until the seventh day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine, when the said Isaiah Turner shall attain the age of twenty one years, during all which time the said Isaiah Turner shall the said Conrad Hagleman, well and faithfully serve in all such lawful business as the said Isaiah Turner shall be put unto by his said master, according to the power and ability of him the said Isaiah Turner, and honestly and obediently in all things shall behave himself towards his said master and honestly and ardently towards the rest of the family of the said Conrad Hagleman. And the said Conrad Hagleman on his part doth covenant and agree to pay or cause to be paid unto the said Willy Turner, the
