Welch on his part do hereby promise Covenant and agree to teach and instruct the said Apprentice or cause him to be taught and instructed in the art of a Farmer the best way or means he can; and also to teach and instruct the said George N. Scott or cause it to be done to read, write Cypher &c. as far as the rule of three; and shall well and faithfully find and provide for the said Apprentice during the term for which he is bound, good sufficient meat drink, Clothing, Lodging and other necessities fit and convenient for such an apprentice during the term aforesaid; and at the expiration thereof shall give unto the said Apprentice two suits of Clothing, one suitable for labour and the other suitable for Sunday.
