Franklin shall obtain to the age of twenty one years of age, during all of which time and term, the said Joseph shall the said John Satchford, well and faithfully serve, in all such lawful business as the said Joseph shall be put unto by his said master, according to the power and ability of him the said Joseph, and honestly and obediently in all things shall behav himself towards his said master, and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the family of the said John Satchford, and the said John Satchford on his part, doth hereby promise, covenant and agree, to well and faithfully find and provide for the said Joseph, good and sufficient meat drink, clothing, lodging and other necessaries fit and convenient for said Joseph, during the term aforesaid and at the expiration thereof shall give unto the said Joseph two suits of wearming apparel, one suitable for Sundays and the other for working days. In testimony whereof the said Abraham Franklin and John Satchford, have hereunto interchangeably set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
