I John Gaw of Howard County in the State of Maryland, being now indebted to Samuel Canby, of the City of Baltimore, in the sum of five hundred dollars, for

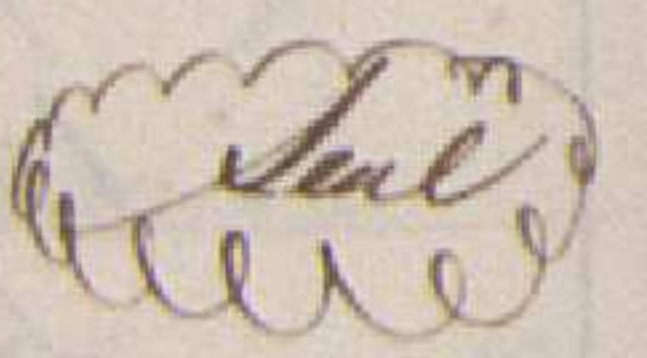
