Comfort W. Dorey
 Bill of Sale to
 James MacRabin

This Indenture made this sixth day
 of June in the year Eighteen hundred
 and fifty seven, by & between Comfort
 W. Dorey of Baltimore City & State of

Maryland of the one part, & James MacRabin of Howard County
 & same State of the other part. Witnesseth, that the said
 Comfort for the consideration hereafter mentioned hath bargained
 and sold, & by these presents doth grant, bargain & sell to the said
 MacRabin, his executors, administrators & assigns within the
 State of Maryland, a certain Negro Boy, his slave for life,
 called Daniel Webster who will be seven years of age on the
 twenty second day of this month. To have and to hold the
 said negro boy within the State of Maryland as aforesaid,
 until he attain the age of twenty one years & no longer.

And the said MacRabin, his executors, administrators
 & assigns, in consideration of the above, do on their parts
 respectively promise, covenant & agree to well & faithfully
 find & provide for the said negro boy good & sufficient
 meat, drink, clothing, lodging and other necessaries fit and
 convenient for such a boy, & to treat him in all respects as
 such a servant boy ought to be treated, during the term
 for which he is above bargained & sold. In testimony
 whereof the said Comfort W. Dorey & James MacRabin
 do hereunto set their hands & seals the day & year first
 above written.
