Indenture of Apprenticeship  
Betwixt Kelly Cromwell  
to  
Edward A. Trimble

This Indenture, made this fourteenth day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven, between Kelly Cromwell a free mulatto of Howard County, in the State of Maryland, of the one part, and Edward A. Trimble of Baltimore County and State aforesaid, of the other part - witnesseth, that the said Kelly Cromwell hath placed and bound out and by these presents doth place and bind out, his daughter Mary Ellen Cromwell who on the twelfth day of July next will be of the age of fourteen years, as an apprentice to the said Edward A. Trimble, to learn the art and mystery of housework generally, after the manner of an apprentice; the said Mary Ellen to dwell with and serve the said Edward A. Trimble, from the date of these presents, until the twelfth day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty one, when the said Mary Ellen shall attain to the age of eighteen years, during all which time and term the said Mary Ellen shall the said Trimble well and faithfully serve in all such lawfull business as the said Mary Ellen shall be put unto by her said master according to the power and ability of her the said Mary Ellen, and honestly and obediently in all things shall behave herself towards her said master, and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the family of the said Edward A. Trimble. And the said Edward A. Trimble on his part, doth hereby promise covenant and agree to teach and instruct the said apprentice, or cause her to be taught and instructed, in the art, trade or calling of housekeeping, by the best way or means he can, and shall well and faithfully find and provide for the said Apprentice good and sufficient meat, drink, Clothing, Lodging and other necessaries, fit and convenient for such an apprentice during the term aforesaid, and at the expiration thereof shall give unto the said Apprentice, two suits of warming apparel, one suitable for Sundays and the other for working days -

In testimony whereof the said Kelly Cromwell and Edward A. Trimble have hereunto interchangably set their hands and sealed the day and year first above written -
