
I know all men by these presents,  
that August Wallenburet of Howard  
County and State of Maryland, for  
and in consideration of the sum

of two hundred dollars lawful money of the United States,  
in hand paid by Thomas M. Crea at or before the sealing  
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged: have granted, bargained and sold, and  
by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said  
Thomas M. Crea his executors, administrators and assigns,  
the following goods and Chattels: merchandise & fixtures to-wit,  
one bed & bedding, one Cooking Stone, Five Clocks, two Watches,  
thirty finger rings, one doz. pair Earrings, two doz. pair of gold  
Breast pins, two bracelets, one gold and one hair, one gold and  
one silver pencil, one doz. pair Spectacles, three glass watch  
Crystals, three <sup>pair</sup> ~~trussed~~ beads and three string beads, six  
Silver Tea Spoons, six Silver table Spoons, one Silver Ladle,  
one Counter, one Show Case, one gold Chain and three plated  
Chamo.

To Have and To Hold the said described  
property goods wares merchandise and Chattels to the said  
Thomas M. Crea his executors, administrators and assigns,  
forever; and he the said August Wallenburet for his heirs,  
executors and administrators, the said August Wallenburet  
unto the said Thomas M. Crea his executors and administrators  
and assigns, against him the said August Wallenburet  
executors and administrators, and against all and every  
other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant  
and forever defend by these presents.
