I Know all men by these presents,
That August Wallenbret of Howard
County and State of Maryland, for
and in Consideration of the sum
of two hundred dollars lawful money of the United States,
in hand paid by Thomas M^c Crea at or before the sealing -
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged: have granted, bargained and sold, and
by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said
Thomas M^c Crea his executors, administrators and assigns,
the following goods and Chattels merchandise & fixtures to wit,
one bed & bedding, one Coating Stone, Fine Clocks, two watches,
thirty finger rings, one day pair Earrings, two day pair of gold
Breastpins, two bracelets, one gold and one hair, one gold and
one Silver pencil, one day pair Spectacles, three gross Watch
Cryslats, three ^{pair} ~~wrought~~ beads and three strings beads, six
Silver tea Spoons, Six Silver table Spoons, one Silver ladle,
one Comter, one Show case, one gold Chain and three plated
Cham. To Have and To Hold the said described
property goods wares merchandise and Chattels to the said
Thomas M^c Crea his executors, administrators and assigns,
forever, and he the said August Wallenbret for his heirs,
executors and administrators, the said August Wallenbret
unto the said Thomas M^c Crea his executors and administrators
and assigns, against him the said August Wallenbret
executors and administrators, and against all and every
other person or persons whatsoever, Shall and will warrant
and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof,
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifteenth day
of October Eighteen hundred and fifty seven.
