



 person and persons committed to his custody, or by him taken
 in execution, without suffering them, or any of them to escape
 or depart from his custody, and shall also well and truly exe-
 cute and perform the several duties required, or imposed upon
 him by the laws of this State, then this obligation to be void
 and of none effect, else to remain in full force and virtue in law,
