
To all whom it may concern be it  
Known that I Dr. Jonathan Waters  
of Howard County in the State of Ma-  
ryland, for divers good Causes and Con-  
siderations me therunto Moving, do hereby liberate Man-  
umit and set free, and by these presents, do hereby release  
from Slavery liberate Manumit and set free the following  
named negroes, when they shall severally arrive to the ages  
herein specified or mentioned them and their increase re-  
spectively Samuel aged five years & four months to serve to  
the age of twenty eight years, Mary aged five years to  
serve to the age of sixteen years, Hannie or Frances aged  
three years and four months to serve to the age of twenty  
eight years, and I do declare them to be thereafter free  
Manumitted and discharged from all manner of Service  
or Servitude to me, my heirs Executors, or Administrators  
forever, In Testimony Whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and affixed my Seal this fifth day of June in the year  
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight.
