Warfield, of Howard County in the state of Maryland administrator of James Harrison deceased for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars, current money to me in hand paid by William Bottrill of the County and state aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell assign and deliver unto the said William Bottrill his Executors, administrators and assigns one negro boy Joseph slave for life, of dark color and aged about six years to have and to hold the said negro boy Joseph to the said William Bottrill his Executors, administrators, ~~the~~ and assigns forever, and I the said Seth W. Warfield for myself my heirs Executors and administrators the said negro boy Joseph as a slave for life unto the said William Bottrill his Executors, administrators and assigns against me the said Seth W. Warfield administrator as aforesaid, my Executors and administrators, and against all and every other person and persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
