 edged, have granted bargained and sold and delivered and by
 these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said
 Jonathan Marriott his executors administrators heirs and assign-
 os, one negro boy named Andrew, aged seven teen (17) years the
 9th June 1858, to serve until he arrives at the age of thirty one years
 and then be free according to a deed of manumission bearing
 date the eighteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and fifty two, and recorded among the
 records of Howard County in Liber E. P. H. No 2. folio 48, a
 reference thereto being had will more fully and at large appear.

Yo have and to hold the said negro boy Andrew above bar-
 gained and sold to the said Jonathan Marriott his executors
 administrators heirs and assigns which said negro boy Andrew
 I will warrant and defend unto the said Jonathan Marriott
 his executors administrators heirs and assigns, and against me my ex-
 ecutors administrators heirs and assigns and against every other person
 or persons whomsoever. In witness whereof I have here unto set my
 hand and affixed my seal this eight day of November eight hundred
 and fifty eight
