Now the condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Littleton MacKlin shall faithfully execute his office of Treasurer of Howard County and well and truly account for and pay over to the commissioners of Howard County the several sums of money which he shall receive or be accountable for at such times as the law directs then this obligation to be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
