 receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained,
 and sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell, unto the
 said William Brown of Md. his Executors, Administrators and assigns,
 all and singular the goods furniture, and household stuff, hereinafter
 particularly mentioned and expressed that is to say, Two Horses, Two
 cows, one wagon, one ox cart, Two seed plows, Two double and one single
 Shovel Plows, one diamond Arrow, one grindstone, Eighteen Hogs, Two
 bedsteads, one trammel ditto, Three feather beds, one bureau, Two wash
 stands, six cane seat chairs, one clock and two Mahogany Tables to have
 and to hold, all and singular the said goods furniture and household
 stuff, unto the said William Brown of Md. his Executors administrators
 and assigns, to his and their own use and behoof. Provided always
 and it is declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents
 that if the said Catharine E Heckrotte do, and shall well and
 truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said William Brown
