M. Wilder and makes oath that he will faithfully and honestly serve in the office of constable for the second Election Distric of Howard County, and will well and truly, according to his power, skill and judgment, perform and execute the duties belonging to the office of constable so long as he shall continue in said office and that he will, to the best of his ability, perform all the duties required of him by the act relating to negroes, and to repeal the acts of assembly therein mentioned and the several supplements thereto without favour, affection or partiality.

Mayfield, subscribing witnesses to the within bond do make oath according to law that the obligors mentioned in the said bond did severally in our presence, sign seal and deliver the said bond as their act and deed for the purposes herein mentioned. by these presents, sealed with our seals, and dated this first  
day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and fifty nine.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above  
bounden William H. Harrison or appointee a constable in the  
second Election District of Howard County shall well  
and faithfully execute the same office in all things.
