 agree, that he his heirs or assigns shall well and faithfully
 find and provide for the said apprentices and each of them,
 food and sufficient meat, drink, clothing, lodging and
 other necessaries for and suitable for such apprentices,
 during the term and terms aforesaid, and at the expiration
 thereof, shall give to each of the said apprentices, as they
 respectively shall attain the age of twenty one years, a com-
 fortable sum of money apparel and two doll ars in money
