

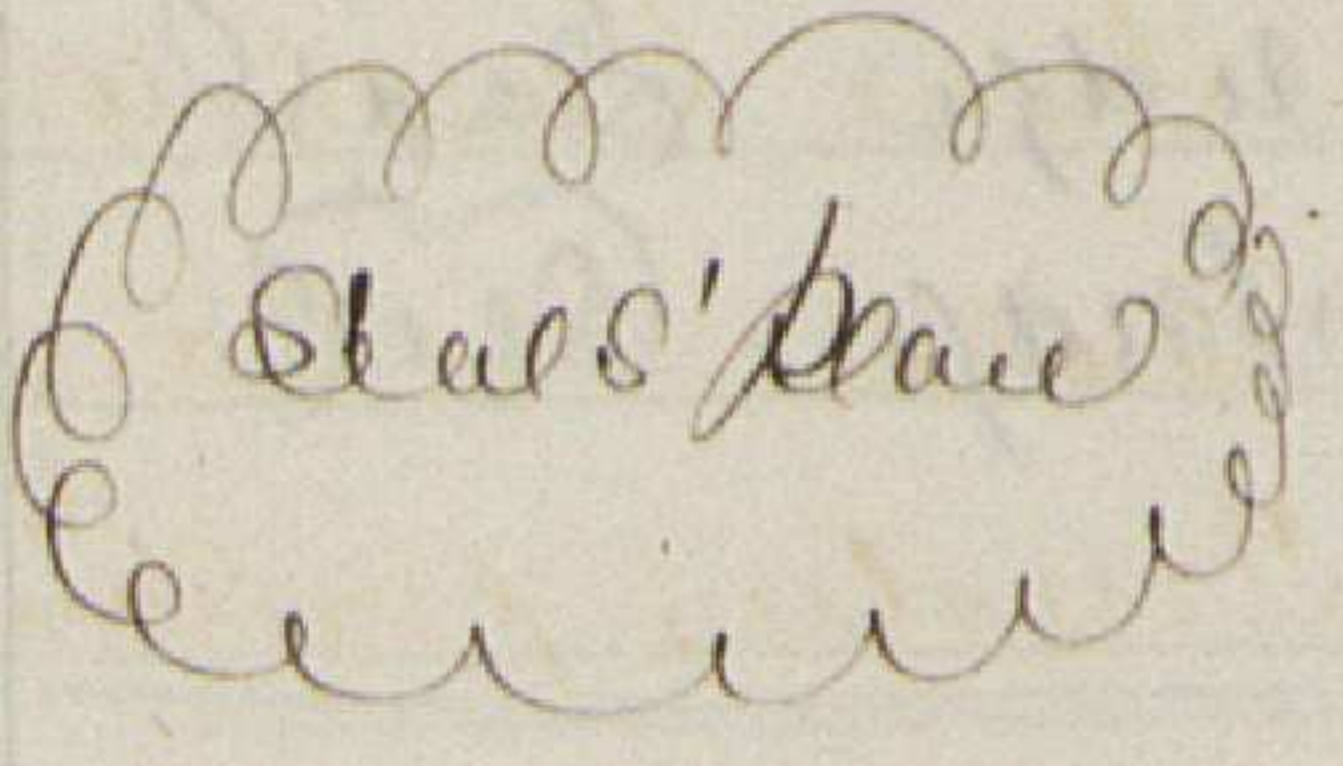

B. Hobbs also my interest in one black mare now in my possession in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 25th July 1859
