This Indenture made this 5 day of
 August in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and fifty nine
 between William Shipley of Howard

 the application of the said William Shipley to the Honor-
 able the Circuit Court of Howard County State of Maryland for
 the benefit of the Act of Assembly for the relief of Insolvent
 Debtors, the said Court, on the said 5 day of Aug appointed
 the above named Mr. Barron Trustee for the benefit of the
 Creditors of the said _____ and did order and direct
 that the said _____

Should execute a deed to the said
 Trustee of all his property, estate and effects, and should
 deliver the same to the Trustee together with his books, papers
 accounts bonds, notes and evidences of debt, agreeably to the
 provisions of the Act of Assembly in such cases made
