Deed of
Manumission to
Negro Charlotte

Know all men by these presents that R. Rainer
Grey (sometimes called Raney) of Howard
County Maryland divers good causes and con-
siderations me thereunto moving as also in
consideration of the sum of five dollars to me
in hand paid, have released from slavery manumitted and set
free my negro slave girl Charlotte Loney (a slave to me for
life hitherto) aged near eight teen years and able to earn a
good and sufficient livelihood and her the said negro
Charlotte I do hereby declare free manumitted and discharged
from slavery to me, and every person and all persons claiming
by through or under me, now hence forth and forever.

In testimony where of I have here to set my hand
and affixed my seal this fourth day of June A. D. 1839
