Know all men by these presents, that I Fanny Howard of Howard County and State of Maryland have placed and put out to Francis Mc' Aroy as an apprentice my boy William Lewis Howard who will be four years old on the 22nd. day of June 1835. to dwell with and serve the said Francis Mc' Aroy as a good and faithful apprentice until he shall arrive at the full age of twenty one years old, which will be on the 22nd day of June 1872. And the said Francis Mc' Aroy on his part is to furnish sufficient meat and drink, washing and lodging, and when the said apprentices term of service shall expire the said Francis Mc' Aroy to give him the customary freedom dues.
