And the said Thomas McCauley on his part doth hereby covenant promise and agree to teach and instruct the said Randolph Fowler or cause him to be taught and instructed in the art trade or calling of a Boot and shoe maker by the best way ^{and} or means he can, and shall well and faithfully find and provide for the said apprentice good and sufficient, meat, drink lodging and other necessaries fit and convenient for such an apprentice during the term of three years as aforesaid, and the said Thomas McCauley covenants that he will pay the said William Fowler the sum of thirty dollars for each and every year time of service of his said son and that he will the said money as it may be earned, and that he will provide and furnish the said Randolph Fowler with a sett of tools such as he may be then employed with, at the expiration of his said term of service as aforesaid
