 office in all things appertaining thereto, and shall well and faithfully
 execute all warrants and other process to him directed and delivered,
 and shall also well and truly pay and deliver to the person or persons
 entitled to receive the same all sums of money, to all goods and chattels
 or other property, by him levied seized or taken, ^{agreeably to the ancient} and also shall
 keep of the said warrant or process under which the same shall
 have been levied, seized or taken, and shall also keep and detain
 in safe custody, all and every person or persons committed to his cus-
 tody or by him taken in execution, without suffering them or any
 of them, to escape or depart from his custody, and shall also
 well and truly execute and perform the several duties required
 of or imposed upon him by the laws of this State, then this obligation
