I George Watson of Howard County
Maryland being now indebted on
my promissory note of even date
herewith to Mrs R. Clark of the Coun-

ty and State aforesaid, in the Sum of One hundred dollars
with interest from the date hereof in Consideration thereof
do hereby bargain and Sell to the Said Mrs R. Clark the
following property to wit. One Grey horse bought of Dr. Mc-
Glocklin one Stallion Called "Belly" one Chestnut Mare
bought of Nathan Hobbs and two new Single Seigles and
two Concord buggies. Provided that If I the Said
George Watson Shall pay to the Said Mrs R. Clark the
Sum of One hundred dollars with interest thereon on or
before the first day of June eighteen hundred and Sixty
then these presents Shall be void.

And provided that if default Shall be made in the pay-
ment of the Money aforesaid or the interest thereon at the
time or in the manner aforesaid then it Shall be lawfull
for the Said John R. Clark. to Sell the Said mortgaged prop-
erty by public Auction, for Cash. after giving at least three
Weeks public Notice of the time, place, manner and terms
of Sale, in one or more Newspapers published at least twice
a week. for three Successive Weeks prior to the day of Sale
to pay the debt and the Surplus if any over to the Said
