Georgiana Haught Bill of Sale to Harriet Blaise

I Georgiana Haught of Howard County and State of Maryland in Consideration of two hundred dollars paid me by Harriet Blaise resident of Howard County

do hereby bargain and sell to the said Harriet Blaise my negro Slaves George Blaise David Blaise & Ellen Blaise to Serve the said Harriet Blaise for the terms of years hereinafter mentioned that is to say the said George to Serve for the term of fourteen years and until he arrives at the age of twenty one years. The said David to Serve for the term of sixteen years and until he arrives at the age of twenty one and the said Ellen to Serve for the term of fifteen years and until she arrives at the age of eighteen years. The terms are to Commence from the date of these presents The said Negroes being the Slaves of Georgiana, and to be the Slaves of said Harriet for the terms above written and no longer And from and after the expiration of said term of years I Georgiana Haught do hereby manumit and set free said three negro Slaves their freedom to date from the day upon which their terms expire
