 presents, the receipt Whereof is hereby acknowledged: Have  
 granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant  
 bargain and sell, unto the Said Matilda Scott her Executors  
 Administrators and assigns, three horses as follows one bay  
 horse Called Sam, one bay horse Called Bill and one Ches-  
 nut horse Called Tom, one Durham Cow Called Anne, one  
 White and red Cow Called Matty, one black and White Cow.  
 and one Cow Called \_\_\_\_\_ one Rockaway, one Market Wag-  
 gon one four horse Waggon and six ploughs, 1 roan  
 Mare 1 Red Cow Called Nannie one Cart, and one year  
 old Heifer Called daisy and one black Cow.
