To have and hold the same in trust for the sole and separate use of my said wife Mary D. Hazelhurst, with full power in her to dispose of the same in the whole, or in part, from time to time, as to her may seem proper, as witness my hand and seal this thirtieth day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty
