

Warfield, his executor, administrators and assigns, against me the said John Shorts, my executor and administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and by these presents forever defend, of all and singular which said goods and other the premises, I the said John Shorts have put the said Charles D. Warfield in full possession, by delivering to him the said Charles D. Warfield one Sorrell Mare at the sealing and delivering of these presents, in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained and sold, or mentioned and intended to be unto him the said Charles D.
