


the receipt whereof I the said James W. Tucker do hereby

 and being in a certain Messuage or tenement, situated  
 in Howard County, and now in the occupation of  
 the said James W. Tucker. To Have and to hold all  
 and singular the said goods, household stuff  
 and furniture, and also the premises above  
 bargained and sold, or mentioned and intended  
 to be so, to the said Jesse N. Williams his executor  
 Administrator and assignor forever, and I the  
 said James W. Tucker for myself, my heirs, executors  
 and administrators, all and singular the said  
 goods, household stuff and furniture, and  
 also the premises unto the said Jesse N. Williams  
 his executor and Administrator and assignor,  
 against me the said the said James W. Tucker  
 my executor and Administrator, and against  
 all and every other person or persons whatsoever,  
 shall and will warrant and forever defend  
 by these presents, of all and singular which said  
 goods, household stuff and furniture, and  
 also the premises I the said James W. Tucker  
 have put the said Jesse N. Williams in full  
 possession, by delivering to him the said  
 Jesse N. Williams one brown Mare at the  
 sealing and delivering of these presents, in  
 the name of the whole premises hereby bargained  
 and sold, or mentioned and intended to be so,  
 unto him the said Jesse N. Williams as
