 ents that I Jonathan Wa-
 ters of Howard County, in
 the State of Maryland, for
 and in consideration of the sum of three hun-
 dred and twenty five dollars, lawfull
 money to me in hand paid, by John War-
 field of (Potsdam) of the County and State
 aforesaid, at or before the sealing and de-
 livery of these presents, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, have granted bar-
 gained sold and delivered, and by these
 presents, do grant bargain sell and de-
 liver unto the said John Warfield of (Potsdam)
 his executors administrators or assigns,
 one Negro boy named Nicholas now
 about Ten years and five months old to
 serve until he arrives to the age of
 thirty one years and then be free, ac-
 cording to a deed of Manumission, bear-
 ing date the eighteenth day of November
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and fifty two, and recorded
 among the records of Howard County in
 Liber E. P. No. 2, folio 428. a reference thereto
 being had, will more fully and at large
 appear. To Have and to hold the said
 Negro Boy Nicholas, above bargained and
 sold to the said John Warfield of (Potsdam),
 his executors, administrators and assigns,
 which said Negro Boy Nicholas I will
 warrant and defend unto the said John
 Warfield of (Potsdam) his executors, admin-
 istrators or assigns and against me my ex-
 ecutors administrators and against every
 other person or persons whomsoever, In witness
 whereof we have hereunto set our hands
 and affixed our seals this 31st day of March
 one thousand eight hundred and fifty five,
