and thirty five, I the under-
signed M^{rs} Jane Brown, did
execute a deed of manumission,

whereby it was my intention to liberate my negro girl Jane when she should attain the age of forty years, and her issue as she same should attain the age of thirty five years, which deed was duly recorded among the manumission books of Anne Arundel County in Liber C. et c. 3. folio 567. but is believed to be defective because executed ~~only~~ before ^{only} one witness; and whereas the said Jane has since then had issue a number of children, of whom are now living Charles, Harriet, Maria, George, and William, and it is my desire
