


Know all men by these presents that I John Thomas Harwood of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars current money of the United States to me in hand paid by Thomas Davidson of the county and State aforesaid before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the said John Thomas Harwood do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Davidson his executors, administrators and assigns, one negro boy named William about ten years old, one dark bay mare, one yoke of oxen, one ox cart, two milch cows (both red and white) two calves, one blue roan heifer, one sow, two Shoats, four feather beds, four bedsteads and furniture twelve chairs six Iron pots, two Iron Ovens, two kettles one Spider one Walnut table one man's saddle, one woman's saddle, two Bridles, three guns, two Trunks, two Chests, one pair large brass And Irons and a crop of Corn now on the ground, and also two axes, one Plough and two sets gear, and now in my possession To have and to hold the said property to the said Thomas Davidson his executors administrators and assigns forever and I the said John Thomas Harwood for myself, my heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid property to the said Thomas Davidson his executors administrators and assigns and against all and every person or persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. Provided nevertheless that in case I the said John Thomas Harwood shall pay and satisfy unto the said Thomas Davidson or to his executors, administrators or assigns the sum of Three hundred dollars current money with Interest for the same on or before the first day of March Eighteen hundred and thirty then this Bill of sale and every matter and thing therein expressed shall be void and of no effect it being the true intent and meaning thereof that the said property is mortgaged by me the said John Thomas Harwood to secure to the said Thomas Davidson the payment of the money aforesaid. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine.

Maryland Anne Arundel County, to wit: On this 7<sup>th</sup> day of October 1839 before me one of the justices of the peace in and for the said County appears John Thomas Harwood and acknowledge the foregoing writing to be his act and deed according to the true intent and meaning thereof and the act of assembly in such case made and provided.
