Barber of the State of Maryland and Anne Arundel County for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Caleb White of Anne Arundel County at and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained, sold and delivered unto the said Caleb White and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto the said Caleb White his executors, administrators or assigns one Mulatto Girl named Betty To have and to hold the said Mulatto Girl Betty above bargained, sold and delivered to the said Caleb White his executors, administrators and assigns forever to his and their only use and benefit and I the said George A. Barber for myself my executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Caleb White his executors, administrators and assigns the said Mulatto Girl above mentioned against me my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming the said negro Girl Betty In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 27th day of October Eighteen hundred and twenty nine.

Barber of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred dollars to me in hand paid by George Barber of the City of Annapolis at and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained, sold and delivered unto the said George Barber and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto the said George Barber his executors, administrators and assigns one negro woman Mary, one ditto Child named Prip Three Acres, one Bull, Two Cows, one Sorel Horse, one do mare, one dark Bay do, one Colt two years old, one do eighteen months old, Twelve Sheep, Five Hogs, one Cart about fifty Barrels of corn about twelve hundred weight of Tobacco Three Bedsteads, Four Beds and furniture, Two mahogany Tables, one carpet, Two Dinner Pots, one Oven, Three pair of And Irons all which property is now in my possession To have and to hold the said described property above bargained, sold and delivered to the said George Barber his executors, administrators and assigns forever to his and
