

On the 27th day of Oct. 1829 appeared George A Barber before the subscribed one of the justices of the peace for Anne Arundel County and acknowledges the above instrument of writing to be his act and deed according to the true intent and meaning thereof and the act of assembly in such case made and provided.

Know all men by these presents that I Isaac Walker of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars current money of Maryland to me in hand paid by Reuben Johnson of Montgomery County and State aforesaid, at or before the enacting and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Isaac Walker do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Reuben Johnson his executors administrators and assigns, one black boy named Hanson Two Horses Four head of Cattle Six head of Hogs, eight head of Sheep, one Cart and Gear, one Seed Plough and one Shovel Plough and the Gear, all the Household and Kitchen furniture I now possess also all the Hay Straw, Corn, Corn Fodder, Oats and Oat Straw now on the premises, also Rye and Rye Straw, one Harrow, and now in my possession. To have and to hold the said described property to the said Reuben Johnson his executors, administrators and assigns forever and I the said Isaac Walker for myself, my heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid described property to the said Reuben Johnson his executors, administrators and assigns, against me the said Isaac Walker my executors and administrators and against all and every person and persons whomsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. Provided nevertheless that in case I the said Isaac Walker shall pay and satisfy to the said Reuben Johnson, or his executors, administrators or assigns the sum of eight hundred dollars current money, with Interest for the same on or before the twenty sixth day of October, one thousand eight hundred and thirty one next ensuing, then this Bill of sale and every matter and thing therein expressed shall be void and of no effect, it being the true intent and meaning thereof, that the said described property is mortgaged by me the said Isaac Walker to secure to the said Reuben Johnson, the payment of the money aforesaid.
