

Anne Arundel County Sep. 8th 1829. Know all men by these presents, that I, Jno H Maccubbin of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland, for the consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars current money to me in hand paid, by William Cooke of the county and State aforesaid, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold and delivered and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto the said William Cooke my negro woman Jenny & child to serve until they are twenty five years of age I will warrant and defend to the said Cooke his executors, administrators and assigns against me my executors and administrators and against every other person or persons whomsoever laying any lawful claim thereto In witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my seal this eight day of September eighteen hundred and twenty nine.

Know all men by these presents, that I Dennis R. Ridgely of Anne Arundel County, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars and sixty six cents current money, to me in hand paid by Reuben Warfield of the county aforesaid, before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof I the said Dennis R. Ridgely do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell to the said Reuben Warfield, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns all my crops of Tobacco now in the Tobacco Houses, one Brown Mare, one dark Roan, both one year old, three cows, all my crops of Rye and Wheat now in the ground, one Stack Rye, all my corn in the fields and Corn House, one set of Carpenters Tools, Two Leather Beds, Bedsteads and furniture, one Bureau, one Cupboard and Crochery ware, with all and singular my other household and kitchen furniture of every description all of which said property are now in my possession To have and to hold all and singular the goods, household stuff and furniture above bargained and sold, or mentioned or intended so to be, to the said Reuben Warfield his executors, administrators and assigns forever, and I the said Dennis R. Ridgely for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators all and singular the goods above mentioned to the said Reuben Warfield his executors, administrators & assigns against me the said Dennis R. Ridgely my executors & administrators and against all & every other person and persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant & forever defend by these presents In testimony whereof the said Dennis R. Ridgely has hereto set his name and affixed his seal this 2nd Nov: 1829.
