

Know all men by these presents that I David Stewart of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of thirty two dollars and fifty cents current money to me in hand paid by Charles Pumphrey of the State and County aforesaid have bargained and sold and doth by these presents bargain and sell unto the said Charles Pumphrey my negro boy named Daniel to serve him for life. Now the condition of this obligation is such that if the said David Stewart doth satisfy and pay to the said Charles Pumphrey his heirs or assigns the just and full sum of thirty two dollars and fifty cents aforementioned with legal interest thereon from the date hereof, on or before the twenty ninth day of April 1830, then this obligation to be void and of none effect else to be, and remain in full force and virtue in law as witness my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of October 1829.



Know all men by these presents that I, John Henry McCubbin of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland, for ~~and in~~ <sup>the</sup> consideration of the sum of Six hundred and fifty dollars current money, to me in hand paid by Charles Waters of the County and State aforesaid, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained sold and delivered (or promise to deliver within five days from this date) and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver (or promise to deliver within five days from this date) unto the said Charles Waters at his residence, my mulatto slave Tom aged about 25 years, my negro slave Ben aged about 15 years, slaves for life, also my negro servant Dary aged about 15 years, to serve 15 years from this date, which said slaves Tom and Ben and servant Dary, I will warrant and defend to the said Charles Waters his executors, administrators and assigns, against me my executors and administrators and against every other person or persons whomsoever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my seal this third day of November 1829.
