 Jonathan H. Ellicott his executors, administrators and assigns forever; and I the
 said Ann Carroll for myself my heirs executors and administrators, all and
 singular the said Negro unto the said Jonathan H. Ellicott his executors
 administrators and assigns, against me the said Ann Carroll my executors and
 administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall
 and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and seal this eighteenth day of December eighteen hundred
 and twenty nine.
