Know all men by these presents that I John Chaney of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty dollars to me in hand paid by John Chaney Jr at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained and sold unto the said John Chaney Junior the following property to wit one Cow and Calf (Three Hogs, Three Beds and furniture on them, Six Chairs, one Table, Two Iron pots, one Dutch Oven, one Kettle, one Whillet, one dozen earthen plates and two dishes (To have and To hold the said personal property above described to him the said John Chaney Jr his heirs and assigns forever and I the said John Chaney for myself my heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid property to him the said John Chaney Jr his heirs and assigns against me the said John Chaney my heirs executors or administrators and against all and every person claiming the said property above described or any part of the same shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents Provided however and it is understood that in case the said John Chaney shall pay unto John Chaney Jr the aforesaid sum of Sixty dollars with Interest on or before the first day of January 1831 then and in that case this Bill of sale of none effect otherwise to be in full force and virtue in Law.
