



in hand paid by William A. Botler of Prince Georges County and State aforesaid at
and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto
the said William A. Botler his executors administrators and assigns one negro man by the
name of Charles aged about twenty five or thirty years old, four feather beds and
furniture, one cart and two horses, three head of horned cattle two calves, ten Sheep, &
two hogs, all of the farming utensils and household & kitchen furniture, all which
property is now in my possession To have and to hold the same described property above
bargained and sold to the said William A. Botler his executors administrators and assigns
forever to his and their only proper use and benefit and I the said John Osborn for
myself my executors and administrators, shall and will warrant and forever defend by
these presents to the said William A. Botler his executors administrators and assigns the
said described property against me my executors and administrators and against all
and every person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof In testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this thirtieth day of January 1830.
