Know all men by these presents that I Thomas King of the City of Annapolis in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars current money to me in hand paid by William Brewer and Philip Clayton of the same place at and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said William Brewer and Philip Clayton their executors administrators and assigns one gray mare one bay horse and one Cow all which property is now in my possession: To Have and To Hold the same described property above bargained and sold to the said William Brewer and Philip Clayton their executors administrators and assigns forever, to them and their only proper use and benefit and I the said Thomas King for myself my executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said William Brewer and Philip Clayton their executors, administrators and assigns the said described property against me my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the twenty second day of January, eighteen hundred and thirty.
