Know all men by these presents that I George Louse of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of sixty two dollars eighty cents current money to me in hand paid by Leonard Iglehart and Caleb White of the County and State aforesaid at or before the making and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I do acknowledge have granted bargained and sold to the said Leonard Iglehart and Caleb White their executors administrators and assigns sixty sides of Leather which is now in my possession To Have and To Hold the said Leather to the said Leonard Iglehart and Caleb White their executors administrators and assigns forever and I the said George Louse for myself my heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid Leather to the said Leonard Iglehart & Caleb White their executors administrators and assigns against me the said George Louse my executors and administrators and against all and every person or persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents Provided nevertheless that in case I the said George Louse shall pay and satisfy to the said Leonard Iglehart and Caleb White or to their executors administrators or assigns the sum of Sixty two dollars eighty cents with Interest for the same on or before the twentieth day of August next ensuing then this Bill of sale and every matter and thing therein expressed shall be void and none effect it being the true intent and meaning thereof that the said Sixty sides of Leather is mortgaged by me
