Know all men by these presents that I John Porter of the City of Baltimore and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars current money to me in hand paid by Rachel Bome a free man of color (manumitted and set free from slavery by Mrs. Rachel Snowden) of Anne Arundel County and State aforesaid, at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I the said John Porter do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Rachel Bome his executors, administrators and assigns a certain negro woman slave named Mary supposed to be about twenty one years of age. To Have and To Hold the said Negro woman slave named Mary above bargained and sold or intended to be, to the said Rachel Bome his executors administrators and assigns forever. And I the said John Porter for myself my heirs executors and administrators the said negro woman named Mary as a slave unto the said Rachel Bome his executors administrators and assigns against me the said John Porter my heirs executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and well warrant and forever defend by these presents, and I the said John Porter have put the said Rachel Bome in possession of said negro woman by delivering her to him at the sealing and delivery of these presents. In witness whereof I the said John Porter hath hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this fourth day of March eighteen hundred and thirty.
