

In Testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand & affix the seal of Baltimore County Court this 4th day of March 1830.

This deed made this fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty between Vachel Bome a free man of color of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland of the one part and John Ewell of the same County and State aforesaid of the other part. Whereas the said Vachel Bome owes and stands fully indebted to the said John Ewell in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars current money with Interest thereon from the date hereof. Now this deed witnesseth that the said Vachel Bome in consideration of the said sum of one hundred and fifty dollars current money as aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof with Interest and also in consideration of the further sum of five dollars current money to him in hand paid by the said John Ewell at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said John Ewell his executors, administrators and assigns a certain negro woman named Mary, sold to me by a certain John Porter of Baltimore city as a slave, by his Bill of sale of said negro woman to me bearing date on the fourth day of March eighteen hundred and thirty. To Have and To Hold the said negro woman slave named Mary now in the possession of the said John Ewell unto him the said John Ewell his executors & administrators and assigns. Provided however and it is the true intent and meaning of this deed and of the said parties hereunto, that if the said Vachel Bome his executors or administrators do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John Ewell his executors administrators or assigns the said sum of one hundred and fifty dollars with legal Interest for the same on or before the fourth day of March eighteen hundred and thirty two, then and from thenceforth these presents, and every matter and thing therein contained shall cease and be utterly null and void any thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.

In witness whereof I the said Vachel Bome hath hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year first herein before written.

At the foot of the foregoing was thus endorsed, to wit:
