

This Indenture made this twenty second day of February eighteen hundred
and thirty between Dorothy Bell of anne arundel county and State of Maryland
of the one part and Margaret Ann Lissee grand daughter to the said Dorothy
Bell of County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the
said Dorothy Bell as well for and in consideration of the natural love and
affection which she the said Dorothy Bell hath and bareth unto the said
Margaret Ann Lissee also for the better maintenance, support, livelihood and
proffitment of her the said Margaret Ann Lissee hath given granted aliened
enfeoffed and confirmed and unto the said Margaret Ann Lissee her heirs
and assigns namely one negro slave named Hilly about Eleven years old and
now in possession of my daughter Isabel Lissee mother to the said Margaret
Ann Lissee and the said negro Hilly is to remain in the possession of the said
Isabel Lissee until the death of the said Isabel Lissee at which time the
said Margaret Ann Lissee is to have free possession of the said Negro Hilly
and all her of spring to her the said Margaret Ann Lissee her heirs and
assigns forever the said Dorothy Bell for her self her heirs executors and
administrators doth covenant grant, agree to and with the said Margaret
Ann Lissee her heirs and assigns by these presents that she the said
Margaret Ann Lissee her heirs and assigns shall and lawfully may from
time to time and at all times herefore mentioned peaceably and quietly
have hold use and possess and enjoy the said negro Hilly and all her
of spring Signed sealed and deliver in the presence of the subscriber a justice
of the peace in and for said County on this twenty second day of February 1830.
